Profile of the College

Thiru. L. Narayanan Chettiar, a renowned philanthropist founded Saraswathi Narayanan College at Perungudi near Madurai Airport in the year 1966. The college is a prestigious academic powerhouse catering to the educational needs of students hailing from economically weaker and socially oppressed section of our society. It imparts education of the highest quality to students irrespective of caste, creed and religion. The guiding principles of our college are duty, devotion and distinction. The institution has proved an innovative leader and a catalyst in the best educational, cultural and economic interests of students. It is committed to make the students morally upright, intellectually resourceful, socially advantaged and globally competent. It is devoted to teaching, research and extension activities with equal importance.

The college set off its academic journey with Pre-University Courses in the year 1966-67. The Institution started offering UG programmes in the academic year 1968-69. It was upgraded as Post-Graduate Institution in 1979-80 and as Research Institution in 1984-85. The co-educational system was introduced for M.Phil. programmes in the academic year 2001-02 and for PG programmes in the year 2002-03 with the noble objective of promoting higher education among girls in rural areas. Girls have been enroled in UG programmes also since the academic year 2010-11.

The green campus of 66 acres of the Institution has a built-up area of 1,70,059 sq.ft. A new library housed at Silver Jubilee building was built at the cost of Rs. 25,00,000/- and it was inaugurated by His Excellency Dr. M. Chenna Reddy, the then Governor of Tamilnadu on 04.04.1994. The library was dedicated to the memory of Achi. The major donor of this building was Tmt. Saraswathi Narayanan, the better half of the Founder President Thiru. L. Narayanan Chettiar. Sri Vidhya Ganapathi Temple was built and consecrated on 27.08.2015.

Departments of Botany, Mathematics, Commerce, English, Economics and Chemistry have been upgraded as university recognized research centres to carryout M.Phil. and Ph.D research programmes in the college. NAAC accredited the college with grade B+ in the year 2005. UGC granted the Status of Autonomy to our institution in the year 2007. NAAC reaccredited the college with grade B (CGPA of 2.78) in the year 2016. UGC extended the Status of Autonomy to the institution for another period of five years from the academic year 2016-17.

College Rules and Regulations

a) Admission and withdrawal

- 1. Admission shall be made as per the rules and regulations of the Government of Tamilnadu.
- 2. Students withdrawing from the College during the course of the year shall pay all the fees due up to the date of withdrawal as well as the special fees for the on going semester.
- 3. If the student applies for the same within 15 days of the following semester. A search fee at the rate of ₹100 per year shall be collected for late application for the certificates.
- 4. Students are strictly advised to collect their Transfer Certificates and Conduct Certificates at the end of the programme of the study. A fee of ₹100 will be charged for issuing certificates other than T.C. and C.C.

b) Payment of Fees

- 1. The fees shall be paid in a lump sum not later than the fifth working day of each Semester.
- 2. Payment with Fine: If a student fails to pay fees on time, a fine at the rate of ₹ 10/- per day shall be levied. If the fee is not paid within the month of the semester, the student shall stand off from the roll.
- 3. If a student leaves the college during the semester, he/she shall have no right to claim remission of the semester fees paid.

c) Mentoring System

A student will be the ward of a teaching staff who will be his/her Mentor. Each Department shall submit to the Principal at the beginning of the academic year, the particulars of allocation of wards to the mentors in the prescribed format issued by the IQAC of the college.

Duties and Responsibilities of the Mentors

The Mentors shall interact periodically with his/her wards. He/she shall consistently watch the progress, attendance and conduct of his/her wards on and off the campus and submit terminal reports in the prescribed form to the respective Department.

d) Attendance and Leave of Absence

- 1. It shall be the duty of each student to attend college regularly and punctually on all working days and go through the course of instructions satisfactorily.
- A student who has to absent himself/herself shall submit an application in the prescribed form to the HOD through his/her Mentor. A student staying in the College Hostel shall submit his/her application to the Mentor with the remarks of the Warden.

The application for leave shall be submitted in advance to the HoD through the Mentor to get the leave granted. In case of sudden illness, the application with medical certificate shall be submitted to the Department. All leave applications with the remarks of the Mentor shall be submitted to the HoD for approval.

In each case, the reasons for absence should be fully explained. The Principal reserves the right to call for a Medical Certificate and to decide each case on merit.

In all other cases, leave applications should be submitted before 3.30 p.m. on the first day of attendance after the period of absence.

3. The granting of leave is at the Principal's discretion. Non-compliance with the rules will entail automatic refusal of leave unless the student explains to the satisfaction of the HoD. His/her failure to comply with the rules and habitual non-compliance will entail imposition of fine or removal of the student from the roll of the college.

- 4. If a student is absent unauthorized for a continuous period of ten working days, he/she will be dropped from the roll. If the cause of leave fails to stand to the satisfaction of the Principal, leave application will not be considered. Unless the student proves his/her absence unavoidable, he/she shall not be considered for readmission.
- 5. A working day comprises five periods of one hour each. Attendance shall be taken every period.
- 6. Reporting to class late without genuine cause shall not be entertained. A student shall request the teacher concerned for leave of absence for a period in an inevitable circumstances.
- 7. The attendance certificate shall not be issued to a student unless (i) the Principal is satisfied with the student's progress and conduct and (ii) he/she has attended three-fourth of the total number of working days in the academic year. The certificate will be withheld for the students who have not attended at least 75% of the classes in the academic year.
- 8. All the scholarship/Fee concession holders should earn at least 90% of attendance, failing which the entire Scholarship/Fee concession amount has to be surrendered to the Social Welfare Department.

e) Conduct and Behaviour

- 1. Every student shall have clean and suitable clothing.
- 2. Every student shall demonstrate the gesture of respect to the staff.
- 3. When a member of the staff enters the class room, the students shall rise and remain standing till they are desired to sit.
- 4. No student shall leave the class room or laboratory without the permission of the teacher concerned.
- 5. Students are strictly prohibited from loitering on the verandahs of the college during the class hours.

- 6. Students who have no class to attend in any an hour shall go to Library. No students on any account shall disturb the classes at work.
- 7. When attending meetings and functions in the college, students should be decently dressed. They should be polite and courteous to all, respectful to seniors and should maintain good order and decent behaviours.
- 8. In regard to matters not specified above, students shall aim at conducting themselves in a manner thoroughly worthy of the college, and in harmony with the best traditions of Indian life and culture.

g) Disciplinary Regulations

- 1. Unfair practices of any kind on the campus are punishable offences.
- 2. No student shall take part in or organize any demonstration or strike.
- 3. Students are strictly forbidden to take part in political agitation directed against the authority of the Government.
- 4. The use of mobile phones by the students on the college campus is strictly prohibited and the violation of this shall attract punishment.
- The Principal or other constituted authorities of the college of Hostel may frame and issue from time to time disciplinary rules of a permanent or temporary character regulating the students' conduct outside the College or Hostel Precincts so far as such rules seen necessary.
- The Principal or other constituted authorities of the College or Hostel shall have the power to execute penalties like fine, withholding attendance certificates, suspension or expulsion from the College, cancellation of scholarships and fee concessions.

h) Library and Reading Room

The College Library consists of two sections viz., the General Library with the reading room and the Departmental Library.

Rules

- 1. The Library and the reading room are open to all the members of the college.
- 2. Students are entitled to keep the borrowed books for two weeks from the date of issue. The books after use shall be returned to the Library on the date marked on the date slip. But they may be retained by the same user, if they are not in the meantime applied for. When reissued, the books may be retained for not more than three such renewals. The books should be produced before the Librarian for every renewal.
- 3. The Librarian may recall the book at any time even if the normal period of lending has not expired.
- 4. A student failing to return a book on the due date shall have to pay fine as per the rules.
- 5. A student who has to pay a fine or any other charge to the library shall not be allowed to borrow books.
- 6. Absence from college shall not ordinarily be admitted as an excuse for delay in returning the books.
- 7. Reference books will not be lent.
- 8. Students are expected to use all books with care. If a book is lost or damaged, the defaulter shall have to replace the books or to pay the current price of the book.
- 9. Practice of soiling, marking, undertaking, clipping, or annotating in the books is forbidden and the violation of this shall attract disciplinary action.

- 10. The student who has used a book shall be held responsible for any damage of the book which he did not expose at the time of his taking it.
- 11. A student who wishes to borrow a book shall submit slips to the Librarian at the allotted time.
- 12. The Library is open on all working days from 9.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m.
- 13. Students shall leave their own books at the entrance of the Library before they enter the Library
- 14. Reference Books can be used with the permission of the Librarian and the books used should not be reshelved by the users themselves.
- 15. No book from the reference section can be borrowed to be used off the library.
- 16. Strict silence should be observed and decorum should be maintained in the library. It is in the power of the Librarian to refuse the issue of books or recommend disciplinary action against the student for breach of the code of conduct of the library.
- 17. All complaints and suggestions should in the first instance be made to the Librarian who will, when necessary, refer them to the Principal.
- 18. Students should return all the library books at the end of their course or at the time of their leaving the college whichever is earlier. All dues should be paid.
- 19. Members of the teaching staff are entitled to borrow 15 books from the Library for their use. All the books borrowed in a semester should be returned to the Library at the end of the Semester and may be reborrowed on need.

- 20. Members of the non-teaching staff can borrow the books they need. Books may be recalled at any time by the Principal, if required.
- 21. Each postgraduate department has its own departmental library for the exclusive use of the P.G. students.

Examinations Rules and Regulations

I) Scheme of Examinations

In the semester, the evaluation of the progress of students is done by the Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA) tests and the Semester examinations. Students shall have to appear for two internal tests. No retest in any subject will be conducted under normal circumstances.

The internal assessment carries totally 25 marks viz 15 marks for the test, taking the average of two test scores, 5 marks for assignment and 5 marks for seminar/interaction in the class room.

II) Semester Examinations - Rules and Regulations

- Students without hall ticket and identity card shall not be permitted for examination.
- Possession of undesirable materials in any form is prohibited inside the examination hall.
- Students indulging in any form of malpractice in the examination are liable to severe penalty.
- Students shall not be permitted into the examination hall after 30 minutes from the time of commencement of examination.
- Students should not write their names or any other identification marking except their Register Number on the answer scripts.
- No student shall be allowed to leave the examination hall before the expiry of at least half an hour of the issue of question paper.
- No paper other than the question paper shall be taken out of the examination hall.

Revaluation and Supplementary Examinations:

Students are allowed to apply for Revaluation within 10 days of the publication of results.

Only final year students having a maximum of three arrear papers are permitted to appear for the supplementary examinations.

Supplementary examinations are to be conducted in July.

Attendance

Only Students having a minimum of 75% attendance (68 days) in a semester stand qualified to appear for the examinations without penalty.

Studens who do not have the minimum attendance should go for condonation.
